## Goat Industry Council of Australia

### Call for Member Nominations from Goat Fibre Industry

The Goat Industry Council of Australia (GICA) currently has a member vacancy from the goat fibre commodity sector of the industry.

Below are the agreed steps and processes for GICA Membership Applications:

1. Call for nominations from organisations that currently have a vacancy/have a vacancy pending
2. Organisations that wish to nominate for a member position on GICA must outline in detail the following questions;
  - a. How many current financial Members does your organisation have?
  - b. Approximately how many Goats does your organisation represent?
  - c. A commitment to pay the GICA membership fees.
  - d. In your nomination, your organisation must demonstrate a clear communication strategy back to all of your industry sector and not just your own organisations membership.
3. Each nominating organisation must put forward the names of the individuals (along with a copy of their resume outlining their industry expertise) and any other relevant experience that they believe could represent their industry sector on the GICA Council. Including:
  - a. demonstrate sound knowledge of the National Livestock Identification System (NLIS),
  - b. demonstrate sound knowledge of the Levy Revenue System;
  - c. demonstrate an understanding of the Livestock Production Assurance (LPA);
  - d. demonstrate an understanding of how the red meat supply chain works;
  - e. demonstrate an understanding of good Corporate Governance;
  - f. outline any previous Board/Committee and Leadership experience;
  - g. outline any relevant memberships of entities within the overall industry;
  - h. other skills relevant to GICA.
4. Your GICA Nominee and your GICA Alternate Nominee, must both be financial members of your organisation's Goat Committee
5. Each individual must sign a declaration of their ability to stand for nomination (i.e. This demonstrates their legal ability to be a Councillor);
6. Each individual must outline to GICA any perceived or material Conflict of Interests that they may have;
7. Current GICA Councillors will only be eligible to vote if they have no Conflict of Interest. These must be declared at the start of the nomination process.

Nominations open from Wednesday, 18 September and close 5.30pm (AEST), 16 October 2019.
